




U.S. Real GDP


Components of GDP: C+I+G+X






U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Months to Recovery from Recessions


U.S. Nonfarm Employment, Number of Months Since Recession Peak


U.S. Unemployment Rate, Monthly





Labor Force Participation Rate


Percent of Population, 16 and Over










U.S. Personal Income, Monthly, \$ Millions, Seasonally Adjusted Annual Rate












Household Debt Burden




Federal Funds Rate Outlook






1-Year Growth February 2022









Jobless Claims in Colorado






Unemployment Rate by County, February 2022






Colorado Employment Change (as of Feb. 2022)






Colorado 2022 Employment Change












Average Weekly Wage Growth




Colorado Employment by Wage Group

Percent Change from January 2020



















Total Value of Construction, \$ Billions


Permits, 1994-2022





FHFA Home Price Index by MSA


1-Year Home Price Change, Q4 2021








Year-Over-Year Percent Change in Leisure & Hospitality Employment






Colorado Public Lands Visits

Colorado Public Land Visits, Millions, 2012 - 2022






Sales Tax Collections

2021 compared to 2019










