

- Cities
- Towns
- Census Designated Places (CDP)


Census Tract

- 1,200 to 8,000 population (optimum 4,000)
- 480 to 3,200 housing units

Census Block Group

- 600 to 3,000 population
- 240 to 1,200 housing units

• Bock Groups: 3,532






data.census.gov: Gunnison County Demographic Profiles (DP)

- 1. Type "DP" in global search
- 2. Using Filters
 - Select Geography or Geographies: CCD Gunnison County
 - Select Year: 2021
- 3. Data.census.gov returns:
- 4. DP02 Social Characteristics (disability status, educational attainment, language spoken at home, veterans)
- 5. DP03 Economic Characteristics (commuting to work, health insurance, income)
- 6. DP04 Housing Characteristics (computer and internet use, house heating source, rental/ownership)
- 7. DP05 Demographic & Housing Estimates (data found in decennial census: age, sex, race and ethnicity)


